The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 11 (c) if available, manufacturer instructions for proper storage;
- 12 (d) any common reasonably anticipated adverse effects associated with

- 14 (e) if available, manufacturer precautions and relevant warnings.

TITLE OF BILL:

An act to amend the education law, in relation to information to be provided by a veterinarian initially prescribing or dispensing a drug to a dog, cat, or rabbit; and to amend Buoy's law, in relation to the effectiveness thereof

PURPOSE OR GENERAL IDEA OF BILL:.

To provide technical amendments to Chapter 678 of the Laws of 2022:

SUMMARY OF PROVISIONS:

Section 1 amends section 6715 of education law.

Section 2 amends section 3 of chapter 678 of the laws of 2022, constituting Buoy's Law.

Section 3 extends the effective date.

JUSTIFICATION:

Chapter 678 of the Laws of 2022, (known as Buoy's Law) requires disclosures to be made to pet owners upon prescription, dispensing, or provision of drugs by a veterinarian and becomes effective on June 13, 2023. As written, disclosures are required to be made to pet owners for all animals. This legislation limits the scope to cats, dogs, and

rabbits and changes the disclosure requirements to the initial provision of medication. These changes are necessary to ensure veterinarians can continue to service our pets without sacrificing patient care. Additionally, this amendment extends the effective date to allow proper time for the State Education Department to promulgate regulations.

PRIOR LEGISLATIVE HISTORY:

This is new legislation.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS FOR STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS:

None.

EFFECTIVE DATE:

This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that section one of this act shall take effect on the same date and in the same manner as section 2 of chapter 678 of the laws of 2022, takes effect.
