
COMLEX-USA

Intent & Purpose

- 1 Licensure exam
- 2 Accepted by all state licensing boards
- Required for the DO degree (which is required for licensure)
- 4 Used in holistic review by most residency programs

Attempt Limits

- COMLEX-USA attempt limits changed from six to four in July 2022 for all COMLEX-USA Levels
 - NBOME still permits candidates one additional attempt per COMLEX-USA Level if an individual state board requests
- "Petition for Exception To COMLEX-USA Attempt Limit Policy" form for board to complete and submit is available on NBOME website
 - Requires that candidate seeking the additional attempt has a reasonable nexus
 with state requesting the additional attempt (e.g., resident or native of state,
 attended medical school or in a residency in state, intends to practice in state, etc.)



Comprehensive Osteopathic Medical Variable-Purpose Examination (COMVEX)

- Developed for licensed or previously licensed osteopathic physicians seeking re-entry into the profession
- Administered only at the direction of state medical boards
- Provides reporting on an individual's knowledge of current osteopathic medicine and practice
- Uses the same assessment foundation as COMLEX-USA









COMVEX UPDATES

NBOME updated current eligibility requirements to include:



No more than two attempts in 12-month period



Four overall attempt limit by a candidate



90-day waiting period to retake an exam



Clinical Skills Assessment





WHY?

Delivery of COMLEX-USA Level 2-PE was halted in the beginning of the pandemic in March 2020 and suspended indefinitely in February 2021

NBOME subsequently formed Special Commission on Osteopathic Medical Licensure – purpose was to evaluate alternative pathways for verifying clinical skills

The Special Commission included representatives from medical education and state licensing boards

Currently, clinical skills verification remains in place (through 2027) for COMLEX-USA through a dean's attestation that each graduating student has demonstrated the osteopathic clinical skills necessary for graduation

Arising out of the recommendations of the Special Commission, the NBOME has developed the C3DO, which is a national clinical skills assessment intended to be delivered at COMs.


IAMRA Resolution
