<u>Legislative Committee</u> – Dr. Morgante, Chair, gave a brief overview of pending bills. Ms. Kellogg said the Scope Modernization Bill was reintroduced; it has a new assembly sponsor Assembly woman Sarah Clarke from Rochester. Dr. Cottrell said OP provided bill comments. Dr. Ludwig, from the New York Chiropractic Council, discussed how they are working on an IME bill and non-discrimination bill–Both the New York Chiropractic Council and NYSCA are supportive of the Scope Modernization Bill.

<u>Practice Committee</u> – Dr. Handt Chair, stated the preceptorship issue is still important to get out of state students to be able to do internships and experience in New York State.
