Registered Dental Assistant

A **Registered Dental Assistant** is a healthcare professional who works closely with a dentist(s) and dental teams to provide patient care and support in a dental setting. They play a crucial role in ensuring the smooth operation of dental procedures and helping to create a comfortable environment for patients chairside. Registered Dental Assistants can:

- Provide patient education
- Take patient medical histories
- Take patient vital signs
- Place and remove rubber dams
- Select and pre-fit temporary crowns
- Perform certain orthodontic functions
- Take dental impressions

- Take dental x-rays
- Assist in sterilization processing
- Prepare patients
- Set-up dental procedure
- Pass instruments
- Prepare dental materials
- Remove sutures and periodontal dressings
